

January 13, 1864 - Presence of U. S. C. T. in Eagleville, excerpt from a letter to Dr. U. G. Owen from his mother Henrietta



. . . Yankees & Negroes are stealing [from] everyone that is any account. I have to lock our stock up every night. . . While I am writing this letter there is a company of Negroes passing the road hunting for Abe & Jack. There is a Negro camp^{Note 1} at Eagleville. . .
